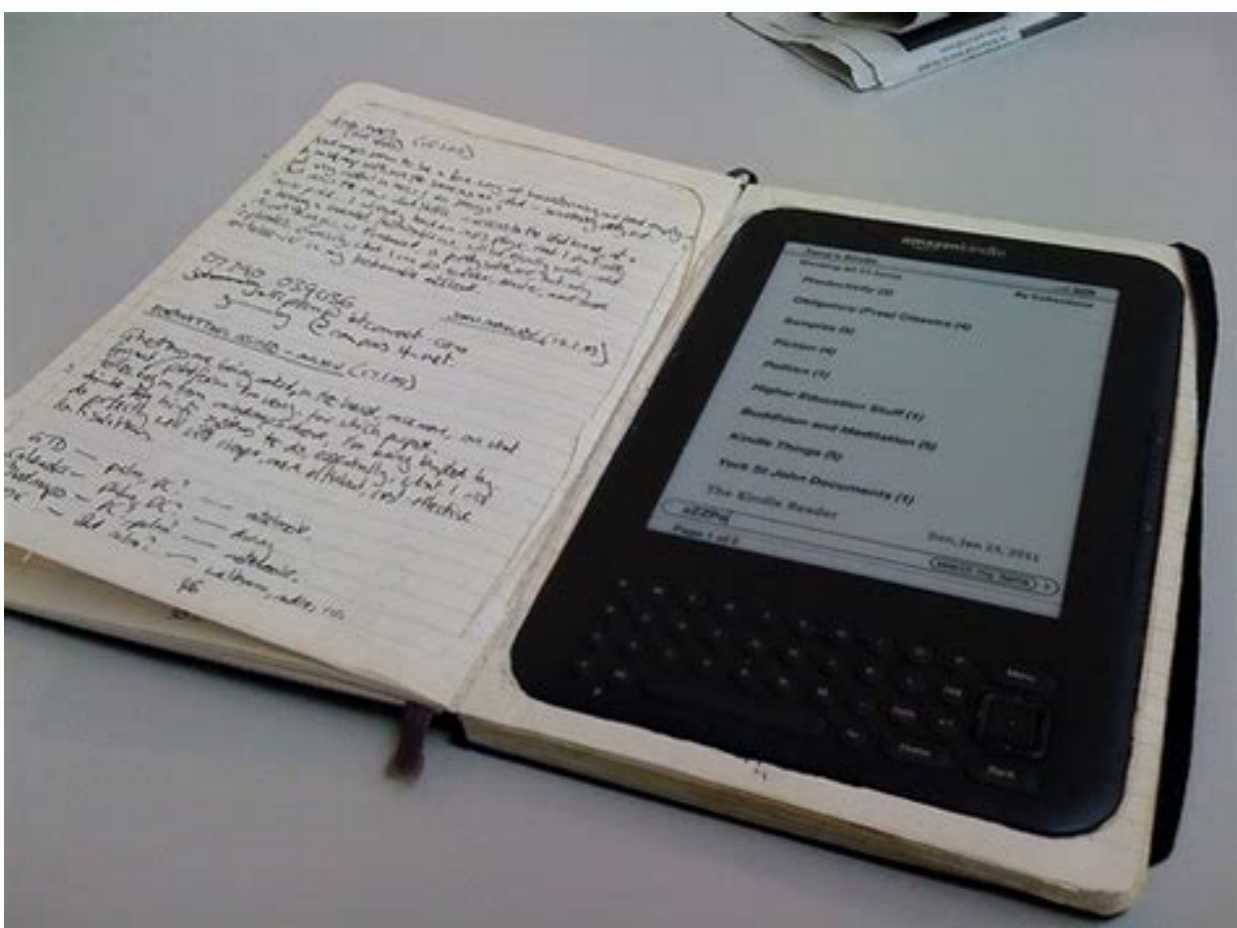

Calibre is a hugely useful ebook management software. It allows you to tag, sort, and otherwise play around with the ebooks in your personal library. And if you're anything like us, you may have accumulated a vast number of ebooks in your Kindle library. It's difficult to meaningfully organize your Kindle ebooks, so here are four ways to organize your Kindle library using Calibre. 1. Use Plugboards to Sort Books Into Series If you buy multiple books in a series directly from Amazon, they will automatically be sorted into Collections, a handy way of separating them out into their own little file on your Kindle. Unfortunately, the Collections feature doesn't automatically apply to side-loaded ebooks. This is where plugboards come in. They're a piece of code which automatically places your book titles into a certain format, meaning they'll be in series order when you sort by title or author on your Kindle. To use plugboards, first, you'll have to ensure the books on Calibre have the appropriate series metadata attached. You can do this by selecting the book, clicking the Edit metadata button in the top bar, and inserting the correct number into the pop-up window (if it isn't there already). The example here uses Munro by Kresley Cole, which is the 19th book in the long-running Immortals After Dark fantasy romance series. Once that's done for all the books in the series, it's time to set up a plugboard. Click off the Edit metadata window and select Preferences in the top bar. You'll see a range of options in the window which appears; click the Metadata plugboards button, located under Import/export. The following screen should appear. From the drop-down lists under Format and Device, choose which type of ebook format (MOBI, AZW3, or KFX) and Kindle you have. In the Source template box, it's time to choose what you want your titles to actually look like. There are a lot of different options, but here are some basic strings and what the output would look like: {series} {series_index:0>2s} [# -] {title}: Immortals After Dark #19 - Munro {series} {series_index:0>2s} [-] {title}: Immortals After Dark - 19 - Munro {series:-|| } {series_index:0>2s}[||] {title}: em>Immortals After Dark [19] Munro Alternatively, if you don't mind doing a bit of coding, you can come up with your own template by reading Calibre's template language guide. Now copy and paste the code (minus the colon at the end) into the Source template box and choose title in the Destination field drop-down. Apply the plugboard (via the tick button at the bottom of the window). The plugboard is now saved. Next time your Kindle is plugged into your computer, you can send books to it from Calibre through the Send to Device button in the top bar. When the books are sent, they'll appear with this new title format, ensuring they're automatically sorted into series order. 2. Organize Your Books by Format You may have multiple different formats of a single book stored on your computer, perhaps left over from when you converted an EPUB into one of the few formats supported by Kindle devices. Calibre will store all of these formats under the single entry which exists for that book, so you don't need to worry about duplicates. However, you can delete unwanted formats to free up space. Highlight the book in the Calibre database. In the information sidebar, you'll see basic metadata such as the cover, series number, and author. Under all of this will be the stored formats for that book. Simply right-click the format you want to delete. When the list of options shows up, choose Delete the X format. You can also do plenty of other things with it, such as saving just that format to a particular place on your hard drive, opening it in Calibre's native ebook reader, or setting a specific cover for it. 3. Get Higher-Resolution Covers With a Plugin One of the pieces of metadata you can edit for your books is the appearance of the cover. Particularly when you're dealing with side-loaded books, you may find that the native cover image is too small, resulting in a poor resolution. The Kindle hi-res plugin will help. Click on the Preferences button at the top, then, under Advanced, click Plug-ins. A window that looks like this should appear. Select Get new plug-ins at the bottom, and a second window will appear. In the Filter by name box start typing "hi-res covers". The correct plugin should appear. Click Install, and once you're back to the first window, Apply. You'll have to restart Calibre for the changes to take effect. Once that's done, however, you'll find that a whole new variety of cover options has opened up to you. Choose a book in your library, then Edit metadata from the top bar, and finally Download cover. One of the options you'll now get will be a high-resolution image sourced directly from the Kindle Store, meaning you never have to independently find and save one yourself again. Using this plugin also means that on your device, the books will have nice, uniformly sized covers, making your library more aesthetically pleasing. 4. Tag and Rate Your Books for Easier Sorting One of the things which makes Calibre so useful is that it has an extensive filing system which lets you tag and rate your books. Admittedly, you can also do this on Goodreads, but if you only want this information for your personal reference, doing it on Calibre is much more private. Searching by tag or rating is also infinitely faster than it is on Goodreads. To rate and tag a book, first choose a book and click Edit metadata, bringing up the usual window. Towards the middle, you'll see a box for inputting your rating. Clicking on the arrow will bring up a drop-down menu that lets you select a star rating from one to five. (Unfortunately, it doesn't accommodate half-stars, but then again, neither does Goodreads). Tagging a book is almost as easy; when you type in a tag for the first time, it will be saved so that you can easily access it again. From the main program, you can now search your books by tag or rating. Calibre Helps You Do More With Your Kindle The range of things Calibre allows you to do is extensive. This includes allowing you to read books by stripping the DRM. Meaning that books bought from Amazon can be read on any other device. Even if you want to stick to reading with your Kindle; tagging, rating, choosing better covers for your books, and more, can all be done on Calibre. Which makes it a must-have program. But sometimes, the book you want isn't available on the Kindle Store. Here's how you can transfer any eBook to your Kindle using Calibre. How to Set Up Calibre on Your Computer We'll be using the free and open-source eBook management app Calibre. It's available on Windows, Mac, and Linux. The app is filled with pro-level features but is also easy to use if you want to do something simple like manage your eBook library or transfer eBooks between devices. The best part about Calibre is that it takes care of converting formats. You don't need to worry about downloading files in the MOBI format (which is Amazon Kindle's default eBook format). Even if you have eBooks in the open ePub format, Calibre will convert the eBook for you before transferring it to your Kindle (as long as you're using a DRM-free eBook). RELATED: What is a MOBI File (and How Do I Open One)? Go to Calibre's website to download the app. After you've installed it, the Calibre Welcome Wizard will guide you through the setup process. The first step is to choose a location for your Calibre Library. You can go with the default location or click the "Change" button to choose a different folder. If you plan to manage your entire eBook library using Calibre, we recommend you use a Dropbox or iCloud Drive folder to store your Calibre Library. Once you've chosen your preferred location, click the "Next" button. From the next screen, choose your Kindle model and then click the "Next" button. On the next screen, Calibre will ask if you want to set up wireless email delivery for eBooks. If you have a Kindle email address set up, enter the details and then click the "Next" button. This is an optional step because we won't be using the email method for transferring eBooks. Now, you have completed the Calibre setup. Click the "Finish" button to launch the Calibre app. RELATED: How to Backup Your Kindle Highlights and Notes How to Transfer Books to Kindle Using Calibre Now that you've opened the Calibre eBook management app on your Windows PC, Mac, or Linux computer, it's time to add your downloaded books. You can use both MOBI and ePub format eBooks. To add eBooks to Calibre, simply drag the eBook into the Calibre window from wherever you have it saved on your computer. In a second or two, Calibre will import the eBook and fetch related metadata, book details, and cover art. Connect your Kindle to your computer using a USB cable. Once your Kindle is recognized by Calibre, you'll see a new "On Device" column next to the book title column. Let's now transfer eBooks to the Kindle's memory. Select a book (or multiple books) and then right-click the selected eBook(s). From the pop-up menu, click the "Send to Device" button and then choose the "Send to Main Memory" option. If you've selected a MOBI eBook, the transfer will finish in just a second or two. If you've selected an ePub eBook, Calibre will ask if you want to convert the book before transferring. Here, click the "Yes" button. Calibre will first convert the eBook and then transfer it. This will take a bit longer, depending on the size of the eBook. You can click the "Jobs" button in the bottom-right corner to monitor the progress. From here, you can see a history of all the imports, conversions, and transfers across all of your devices. Once you've transferred all of the eBooks you want on your Kindle, it's time to safely eject the device. You can do this right from Calibre. From the top toolbar, click the drop-down icon next to the "Device" button and select the "Eject This Device" option. You can now unplug the Kindle device from your computer and start reading the book you transferred. You can do a lot more with Kindle outside the Amazon ecosystem. For example, you can search through and back up all of your highlights and notes from your Kindle device without using any third-party software. Best eReader with color display
